

SJMU–Research Eligibility Test (SJMU-RET) Programmes Ph.D. (by Research)

General Instructions to Candidates:

- (1) Download Application form from SJM University Website and Submit the hard copy of filled application along with DD/details of fee payment on or before 15th September 2022
- (2) Refer Model Question Papers based on courses – Engineering, Pharmacy & Nursing
- (3) The SJMU-RET shall be conducted through multiple choice questions. Each question may be in the form of either a question or an incomplete statement or any other type. Each question comprises four responses, with one of them being the correct.
- (4) The candidate shall select the responses on the OMR sheet and shade/darken/blacken completely the inside area of the corresponding bubble with black ball point pen only.
- (5) Shading of multiple bubbles shall be treated as invalid answer.
- (6) Partial or incomplete shading of the bubble is invalid.
- (7) Bubbles should not be filled by a tick (\checkmark) mark, cross (\times) mark or by hatching ().
- (8) Use of whiteners/correction fluid/Eraser is not allowed.
- (9) Folding/crushing/ mutilating of OMR sheet is not permitted.
- (10) Any type of writing, scribbling etc., on the question paper and ticking the response of a question/s are Not allowed and violation of the same shall amount to malpractice.
- (11) Only non-programmable scientific calculator is permitted in the examination hall and violation of the same shall amount to malpractice.
- (12) Hall ticket along with the identification proof of the candidate (College identity card/ Aadhaar Card/ Driving License/ Passport/Voter ID Card etc.) who is appearing for the SJMU - RET be shown in the examination hall.
- (13) Candidates have to enter the examination hall 20 minutes before the scheduled commencement of the examination.
- (14) Candidates will not be admitted to examination hall, if they report 10 minutes after the scheduled commencement of the examination.
- (15) Candidates shall be permitted to leave the examination hall, only after half an hour from the commencement of the examination.
- (16) Mobile phone, (even in switched off mode), pager or any electronic gadget or programmable device or storage media like pen drive, or any other equipment or related accessories capable of being used as a communication device, either in switched on or off mode, are banned inside the Examination Hall and violation of the same shall amount to malpractice.
- (17) Candidates are advised not to bring any valuables/costly items and bags to the examination hall, as safe-keeping of the same cannot be assured. The examination centres will not be responsible for any loss in this regard.
- (18) Except Hall ticket and identification proof, no other material such as wallets, handbags/bags, goggles, keys, textual material (printed or written), bits of papers, Geometry/Pencil Box, Plastic Pouch, Writing Pad, Eraser, packed or opened eatables, water bottle, etc., shall be allowed into the examination hall.
- (19) Before answering, ensure that the question paper booklet issued to you is of your opted discipline only.
- (20) Handover the OMR sheet and the question paper booklet to the Room Invigilator while leaving the examination hall.
